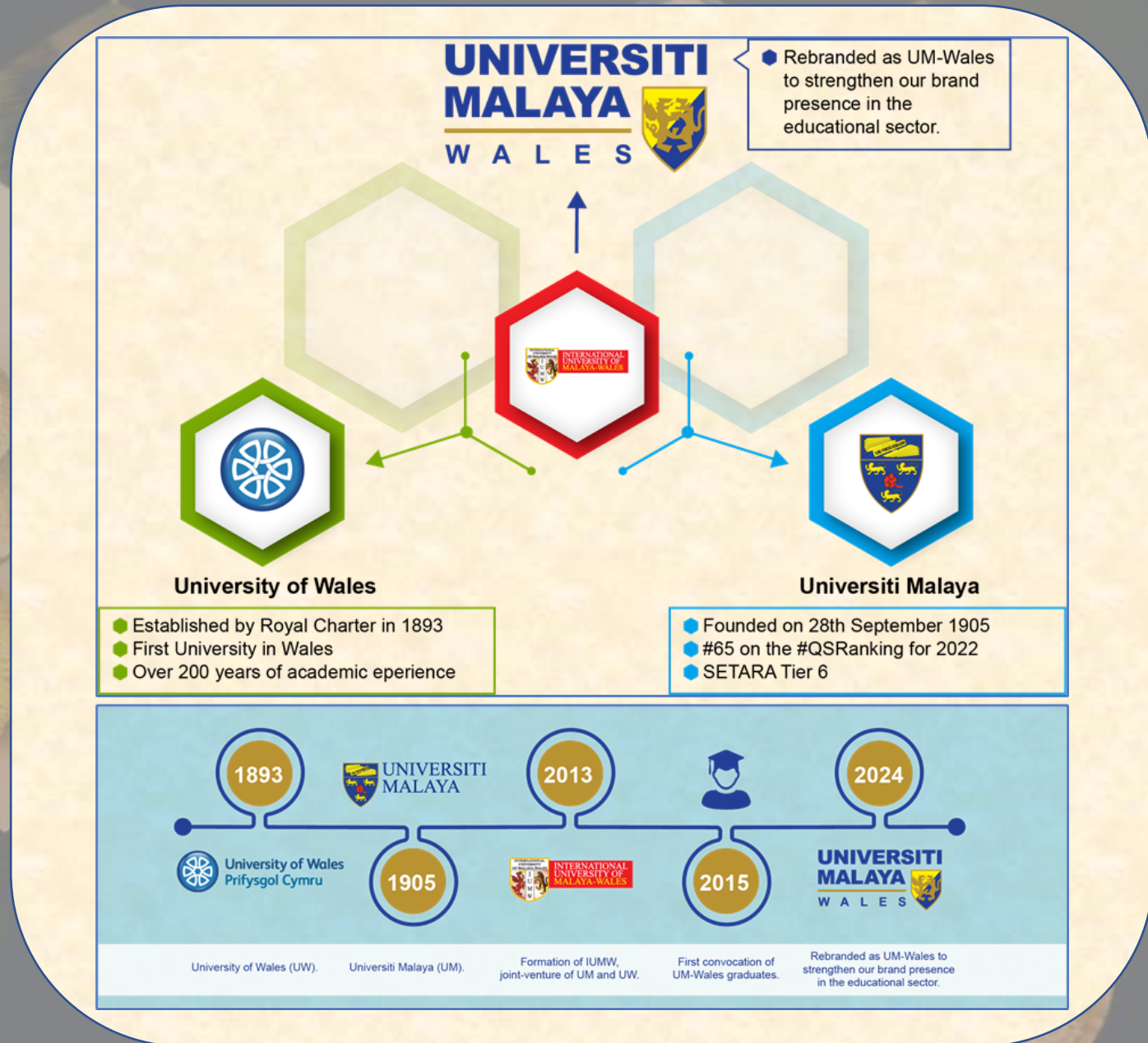

ABOUT THE PROGRAMME

- **INTAKE**

January, May, Sept

Students are expected to undergo three (3) semesters which amounts to 51 credit hours to complete their study.

- **ENTRY REQUIREMENT**

- *O Level Grade C in any five (5) subjects*
- *UEC Grade B in three (3) subjects*
- *IB-Middle Year Programme 28 total points across the certificate's 7 components*
- *Other qualifications recognised as equivalent*

ESTIMATE OF THE COST INCLUDING FEES (TOTAL AND PER SEMESTER), ACCOMMODATION AND OTHER RELATED EXPENSES

TOTAL TUITION FEES

- **Total Fees: RM18,350** (including registration, administration, & tuition fees)
 - Registration Fees: RM600
 - Administration Fees: RM5,000
 - Tuition Fees: Foundation in Arts – RM12,750

GAP YEAR PROGRAMME

- Tuition fees for 34 CREDITS – RM9,000.

OTHER EXPENSES

- **Visa Application Fees / EMGS Fees:** RM2,700
- **LIVING EXPENSES**, a budget of **RM2000 per month** would be comfortable for the student which would include accommodation, transport, telecommunication and personal expenses
Total for 1-year expenses = **RM 45,050 per year** (taking the highest end)

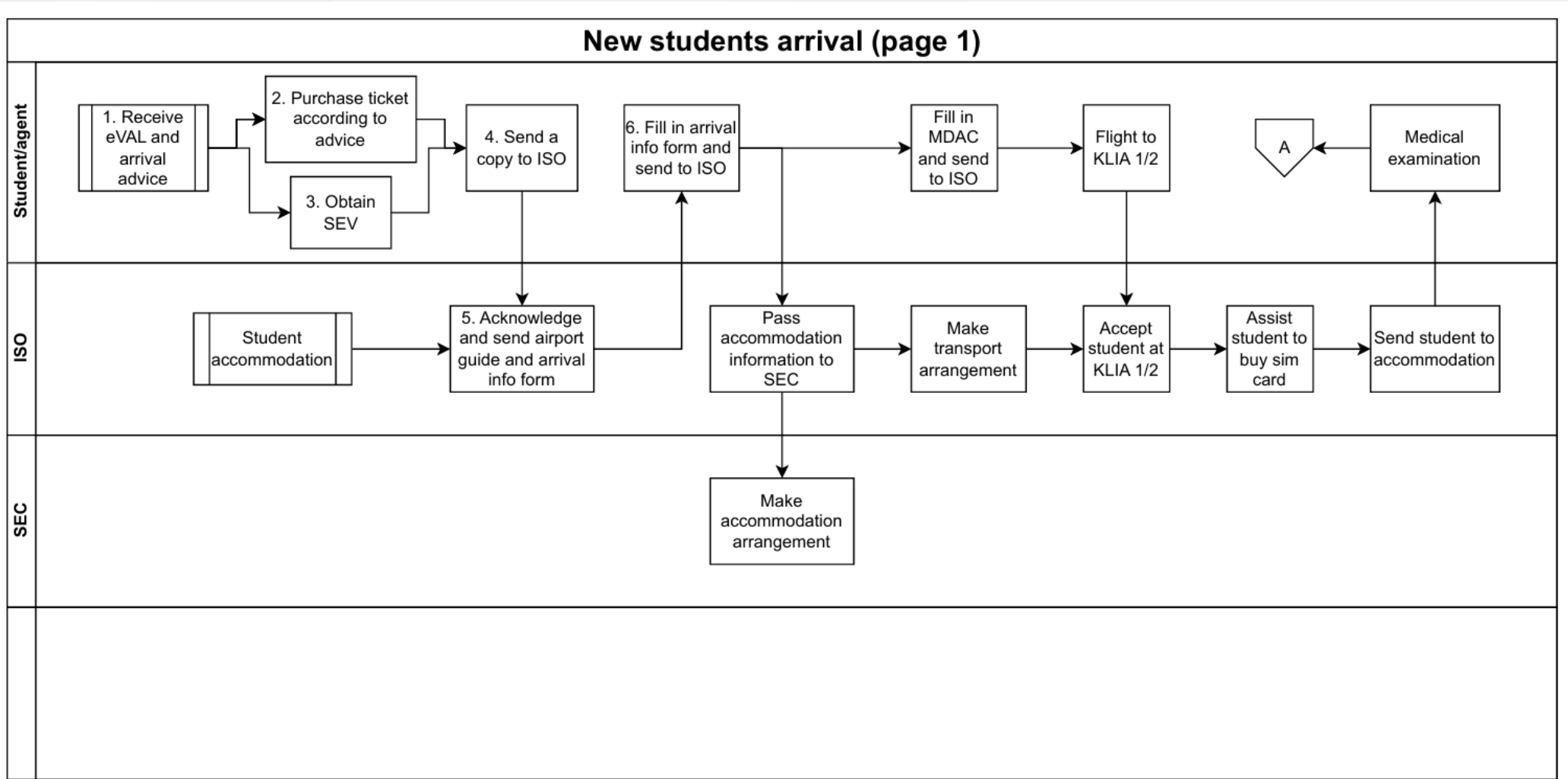

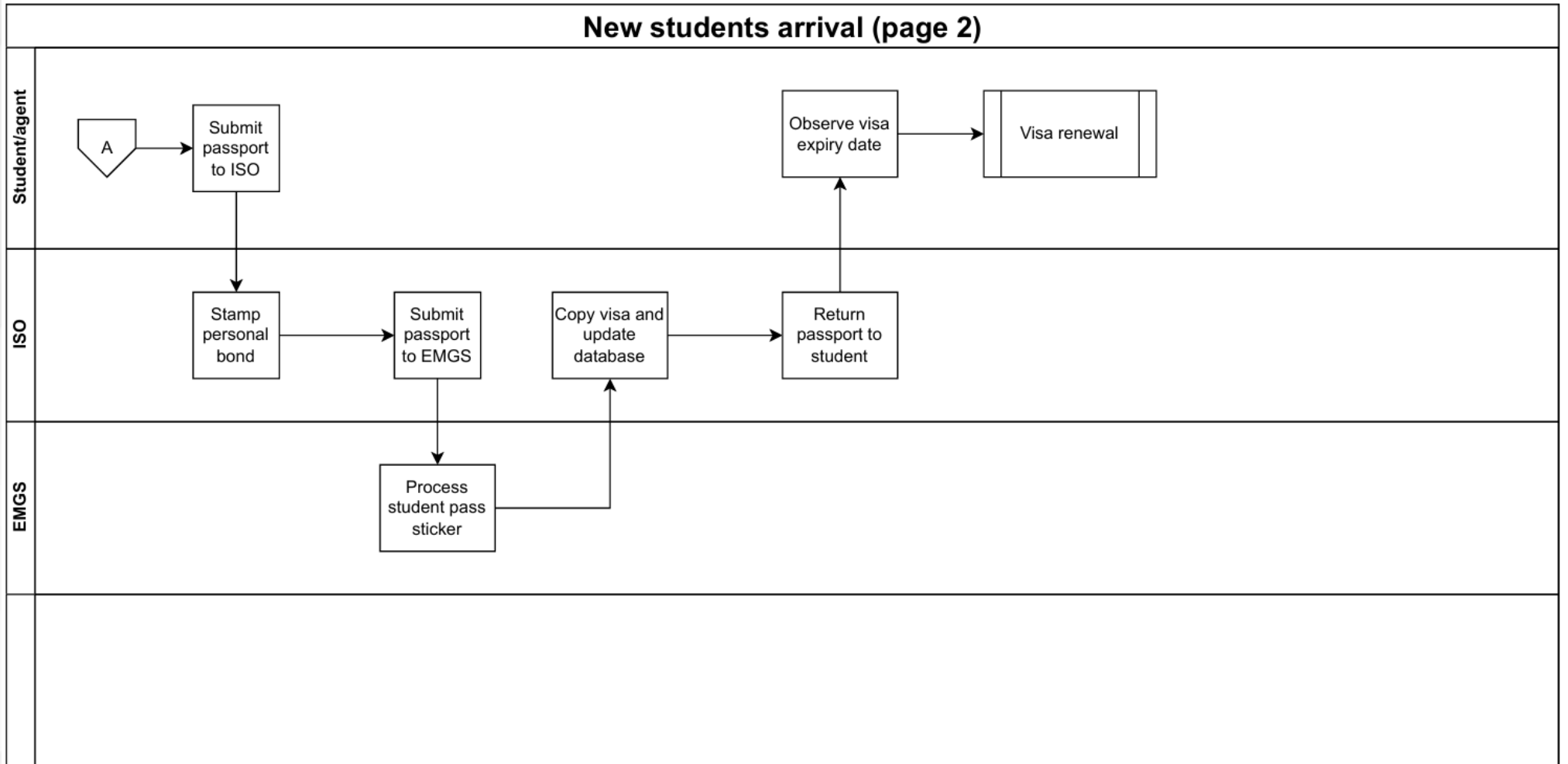
