

• INTAKE

January, May, Sept Students are expected to undergo three (3) semesters which amounts to 51 credit hours to complete their study.

ENTRY REQUIREMENT

- O Level Grade C in any five (5) subjects
- UEC Grade B in three (3) subjects
- IB-Middle Year Programme 28 total points across the certificate's 7 components
- Other qualifications recognised as equivalent


- Visa Application Fees / EMGS Fees: RM2,700


