#### ABOUT US

National Taipei University of Business (NTUB) was founded over a century ago in 1917. It is the only university in Taiwan to focus exclusively on business-related studies. The university comprises thirteen departments within four schools located on two campuses. The main campus is in the urban heart of Taipei, only one subway stop away from Taipei Main Station. Myriad eating and entertainment options are nearby. The School of Management, School of Accounting and Finance, and School of International Marketing are located on the Taipei campus. The rural Taoyuan campus, half an hour drive from Taoyuan International Airport, is home to the School of Innovative Design and Management.



#### Academic Information

- All Exchange Program courses are at the Taipei campus within the Department of International Business.
- Students may also take English-taught courses in other departments with the instructor's permission. The availability of these courses varies each semester.
- Open to undergraduate and graduate students.
- All exchange students must take Taiwan Culture Experiential Service Learning(2 credits).
- Minimum of 4 credit hours required per semester.
- We encourage students to take Basic Chinese (3credits) to enhance your experience in Taiwan.
- Language Proficiency Requirements:
  English We do not require an official language certificate. However, all Exchange Program courses are taught in English. We advise students to have an English proficiency level at least CERF B2(TOEFL 72/IELTS5.5).

Mandarin Chinese Students whose native language is Mandarin Chinese or those who have achieved the equivalent of TOCFL Band B Level 3, HSK 5, or equivalent are welcome to choose from our Chinese-taught courses in all departments.

### **Practical Information**



Acceptance letters will be sent by E-mail. Students may download it and send it to their home university if needed. Original letters will be sent by post upon request.



The Office of International Affairs will hold an orientation day in the week before the semester starts. This is a crucial part of the exchange. It allows students a smooth start to their stay at NTUB and in Taiwan.



It is very important to ensure you are fully insured before arriving in Taiwan. All students are required to purchase insurance that covers accident and medical insurance during their stay in Taiwan. We strongly recommend purchasing an insurance plan worth a minimum of NT\$2,000,000 (approx. US\$66,000).

### Housing

#### Dormitories

- Applications for NTUB dormitories can be filled in using the online form. Please note, these dormitories are not on campus. Travel time between the dormitory and NTUB main campus is approximately 40-60 minutes by subway (MRT).
- Costs range between NT\$3,800-NT\$6,000 (approx. US\$120-US\$190) per month depending on roomsize.
- Rental contracts are for the entire duration of the official exchange semester (6 months).
- NON-REFUNABLE for early checkout.
- All dormitory rooms are shared.

#### Self-arranged accommodation

Taipei City is a very popular international travel destination, so it's not too hard to find a place to live. However, it may take some time and effort to find something that matches your preferences. We urge you to start looking for accomodation 2-3 months before you arrive in Taipei.
